



Cyber Gram Yojana is being implemented under the Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP) of the Ministry of Minority Affairs to equip students belonging to minority community with the knowledge of ICT and empower them to become digitally literate, actively participate in knowledge-based activities and access online government, financial and public sector services.

Free for minority candidates</li> <li>iii. No age limit, but the student needs to provide proof of studying</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Schools/ Madrasas are mapped with CSCs for imparting training</li> <li>ii. Beneficiaries are identified through household survey and registered on portal by training centres</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Registered beneficiaries provided with a unique User Name and Password for online training.</li> <li>ii. Besides basic IT literacy, students further trained to effectively interact with the government system and access G2C and B2C services</li> <li>iii. Post training, CSCs will facilitate free Internet access for students for 30 hours</li> </ul>
